2) Minutes of the last meeting were still pending.

3) DRW updated the meeting on matters related to the CUCBC website and reminded Captains to give appropriate information to their successors where handovers were happening.

4) Bung starts are permitted outside the boathouses on the Monday and Tuesday immediately before the May bumps. PC reminded the meeting that full starts should not be performed in front of the boathouses, only the parts involving the bung and getting away from the bank and bungline.

5) Mays:

Captains were reminded that bank parties are limited to four, including VIPs

Marshals from colleges need to be given appropriate information about when and where to be and Captains were asked to ensure that this reached people who were expecting to do marshalling duty.

Captains were reminded of procedure for stopping a division and asked to remind coxes and coaches of the same.
